Bachelor of Science in Design: INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

Applying to Pass Degree Milestone—Continuing to Second Year

For students that have completed (or are currently enrolled in) DSC 101, IND 120, 121, and 122 with a “C” or better.

Students who are applying to more than one program must submit a separate application for each program. Transfers into programs are limited to students with equivalent course work (see “Transfer Students and Transfer Work”). Transfer students must be admitted to ASU prior to the application deadline to be eligible to apply online to pass the degree milestone. Students that do not pass the degree milestone should see an academic advisor if they need assistance.

Application Deadline and Submission

When: 5:00 pm, Friday, April 15, 2022

Where: Complete [online application](#). This link will be active starting Monday, March 28, 2022.

Policy on Late Applications

- Students who have not applied by the deadline should speak to an academic advisor to help determine their options.

Qualifications

- For students that have completed or are currently enrolled in IND 120, IND 121, IND 122, and DSC 101.

Transfer Students

- Applications will be accepted from students who have previously received approval for the transfer courses equivalent to the first-year required courses.
- See [Milestone](#) for the “Transfer Students Applying Directly to Pass the Degree Milestone” for application instructions.
- If your application includes courses that are being transferred to meet any first-year requirements, it is expected that you request and ensure that an official transcript reflecting completion of those courses be received by the ASU Office of the Registrar by May 27, 2022.
- Transfer students must be admitted to ASU for the fall semester prior to April 8, 2022, and have an active ASUrite ID and password in order to be able to access the online application to pass the degree milestone.
- Please email designmail@asu.edu to receive access to the Milestone application if you are not able to.

Deficiencies

- Must have completed (or be currently enrolled in) IND 120, IND 121, IND 122, and DSC 101.
- First year general studies deficiencies are required to be completed before fall 2022, or the student may be delayed for their graduation.

- Submission of a portfolio is no longer required.

General Information

- If you have retaken a class, you should check with the Office of the Registrar to ensure the lower grade has been deleted.
- Students applying to more than one program must submit separate application materials as required by that major.

Notification of Decision

- Notification will be sent to your ASU email account that you have provided on your application by June 1, 2022.
- It is important that you make sure your ASU email account is functioning properly and that your email inbox has sufficient space to receive emails from the Herberger Institute.

Matriculation

- Students that pass the degree milestone will be expected to begin the second year of the Industrial Design program full time program at the beginning of the 2022 fall term.
