Dear Dr. Saguinetti:

After reviewing the three-year Interim Progress Report (IPR) for the Master of Architecture program submitted by Arizona State University, the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) has accepted the IPR as having demonstrated progress toward addressing deficiencies identified in the most recent Annual Program Review and Visiting Team Report.

A Fifth-Year Interim Progress Report is required and must address the following:

- Condition I.2.1 Human Resources and Human Resource Development: This condition is still not met and additional materials that describe faculty workload distribution to allow for faculty research and professional development is required.
- The report must include annotated minimally passing student work samples and coursework evidence such as syllabi, assignment or project briefs, quizzes and exams, and grading rubrics to demonstrate achievement at the prescribed level for:
 - B.1 Pre-Design
 - B.3 Codes and Regulations
 - B.10 Financial Considerations
 - C.3 Integrative Design.
- Identification of how revenue streams will be diversified for a range of activities and initiatives, in response to planned changes in the program and complexity of the program's budget model within the Design School.

That report is due by November 30, 2023, and a template will be provided.

Your next accreditation visit is scheduled for spring 2027 and will be conducted under the Conditions and Procedures in effect at the time of the visit. The Architecture Program Report (APR) is due September 7, 2026.

Please note that Program Annual Reports are still due annually.
