Arizona State University, Interior Design Program, Bachelor of Science in Design – Interior Design

ASU's Bachelor of Science in Design – Interior Design is a 120-credit hour degree program. It typically takes a full-time student taking approximately 15 credits per semester four years to complete the degree program.

The following data was collected from faculty, advisors, and from institutional records, such as the Institutional Analysis Retention and Graduation report and the Graduate and Alumni Survey.

Student Attrition and Retention:

76% of students admitted in the fall of 2022 returned in the fall of 2023, putting attrition at 24% (30 of 123 students).

Graduation Rates:

Students are accepted into the program after the freshmen year review (i.e., the Milestone). Of the students graduating in spring 2023, 53% graduated in 4 years. A lower rate may be due to changes of major, student pursuing concurrent degrees, and/or students starting the program late.

Acceptance into Graduate Programs:

Two out of 53 students who graduated in 2024 applied for graduate school, and two were accepted.

Job Placement Rates:

85% of students who graduated in 2023 are employed in interior design or a related profession or are attending graduate school.

Arizona State University, Interior Design Program, Master of Interior Architecture

ASU's Master of Interior Architecture is a 56-credit hour degree program. It typically takes a full-time student taking approximately 14 credits per semester 2 years to complete the degree program.

The following data was collected from faculty, advisors, and from institutional records, such as the Institutional Analysis Retention and Graduation report and the Graduate and Alumni Survey.

Student Attrition and Retention:

100% of students admitted in the fall of 2022 returned in the fall of 2023, putting attrition at 0%.

Graduation Rates:

Of the students graduating in 2024, 100% completed the program in 2 years.

Job Placement Rates:

92% of students who graduated in 2023 are employed in interior design or a related profession.
