1. Only those Ph.D. students who have been successfully admitted to candidacy are eligible to apply for the approval of a concurrent degree.
2. A statement of how the concurrent degree compliments the work of the student in the Ph.D. program must be submitted at the time of this request. This statement must be approved by the student's dissertation committee chair and the chair of the concurrent department before submission to the Ph.D. Director.
3. The programs of study pursued must be a well-planned and meaningful part of each of the programs.
4. No more than three courses (maximum 10 credits) from the Ph.D. program of study may appear on the concurrent degree's program of study. These 10 credits cannot be 792 Research or 799 Dissertation credits.
5. The heads of both academic units must approve the concurrent degree.
